DDay 80 years—Lighting of the Beacon will occur at 915pm on 6 June 2024, in line with all other beacons up and down the country. The Beacon is situated on Sleights Moor (Map reference 94/854 057 (4) 85427 (5) 05732).

Everyone is welcome to attend the event held by the parish council and with kind permission of the landowner Grosmont/ Sleights Moor Estate. The Beacon is accessible on foot only by hard tracks from Fairhead/Bluebank – there is no parking at the Beacon. Due to the time of year, being in the middle of the ground bird nesting season, dogs are not allowed and all attendees must keep to the tracks which lead to the site. The ground will be uneven and rough, so attendees should wear appropriate footwear and clothing. The Moor Estate will arrange ferrying of those less able from the Blue Bank car park. As the event will be at night attendees should bring their own torch to light their route. Those attending and using the public right of way access routes do so at their own risk.

Coronation Commemorations: The parish council has agreed to plant a Hornbeam tree to commemorate the Coronation of HRH King Charles III. This will be planted on the green adjacent to the car park at the bottom of Sleights village, and will be next to the two trees commemorating HRH The Queen's Diamond and Platinum Jubilees. The planting is expected to take place at 10am on Monday 4 December 2023, and will kindly be undertaken by the Anglo American sponsored Skills 4 Work Team. All welcome to come and watch!!

The parish council has also commissioned Godbolds Blacksmiths to create a commemorative seat—if anyone visited Egton Show this year they will have seen the seat before completion. The seat will be situated at Blue Bank car park that overlooks the whole parish. Installation will be by NYMNPA Ranger Team before the end of the year.
