Tour of Britain Cycle Race will be travelling through Sleights on Wednesday 7 September 2022 between 1pm and 2pm!

Traffic Speeding: Following reporting of concerns about speeding through Briggswath and Sleights, the Speed Concerns group have undertaken investigative surveys:

- In Briggswath they found that average speeds were 23mph in both directions. The 85th percentile speeds (which shows what 85% of the traffic travel at or below) showed 27mph in both directions
- In the 40mph zone near the A169/B1410 junction the average speed was 32mph and an 85th percentile speed of 37mph

The Road Safety Task Group has decided these would be suitable locations for a Community Speed Watch Group. Previous surveys have indicated that Coach Road and Iburndale also are suitable locations for a Community Speed Watch Group.

The Briggswath Community Speed Watch Group is no longer functioning due to the stepping down of the lead person. Therefore, if residents in the parish wish to form a group to cover some or all of the four areas above, then please email NY Police and express your interest to:

Parking: There is an increasing problem with obstructive parking throughout the parish. The following information is courtesy of Scarborough Borough Council website:

"If a vehicle is causing an obstruction, such as parking on double yellow lines, pavements and grass verges and there is an associated restriction in place in the area (e.g. double yellow lines), a Civil Enforcement Officer is able to issue a Penalty Charge Notice to that vehicle.

If a vehicle is causing an obstruction, such as parking on pavements or grass verges and there are NO associated restrictions in place, a Civil Enforcement Officer does not have the authority to issue a Penalty Charge Notice to the vehicle and it is a Police matter.

The Council does not have the authority to remove a vehicle which is causing an obstruction. If a vehicle is causing an obstruction which you deem is dangerous (e.g. blocking access for emergency vehicles) you must contact the Police. The Police have the authority to remove a vehicle which is causing a serious obstruction."
